

PREPARING FOR **THE SECOND COMING**

- Do you have a testimony of the Atonement of Christ and of His role as Savior and Redeemer? Do you feel that the Savior is the center of your worship and of your life? (Rev. 1:8)
- Do you prepare for and strive to keep the Sabbath Day holy? (Rev. 1:10)
- Do you sustain priesthood leaders, despite their human imperfections? (Rev. 1:16–17)
- Do you feel chastened by the Spirit? (If so, it's actually a great sign that you are sensitive to the Holy Ghost; Rev. 2–3)
- Is the Savior your first and true love? Do you have any fish in your life? (Rev. 2:4)
- Is there any hypocrisy in your life? Is there anything in your actions that contradicts your covenants? (Rev. 2:9)
- How well do you prepare to take the sacrament each Sunday? (Rev. 2:17)
- Are there any temptations that you have allowed to enter into your life? Do you feel that your study of the scriptures is enough to overcome temptations? (Rev. 2:26–27)
- How well do you remember the Lord throughout each day? Do you keep a journal? Do you record the Lord's dealings within your life? (Rev. 3:3)
- How is your level of patience with others? (Rev. 3:10)
- Are you truly grateful and content with what you've been given? (Rev. 3:17)
- Do you actively and eagerly volunteer your time, talents, and possessions to help others? (Rev. 4:10, 5:10)
- Do you pray each morning before your day begins and kneel each night to pray again? (Rev. 5:8)
- How would you rate the level of purity in your life? Are you free from media that shows violent imagery? (Rev. 6:2, 4)
- How would you rate your level of temporal preparedness (e.g., food storage, disaster preparedness, savings) for the Second Coming? (Rev. 6:5)
- Do you actively live the gospel? Do you home/visit teach each month? Are you a blessing to your ward and neighborhood? Are you a high-yield, low-maintenance Saint? (Rev. 6:9–11)
- Do you keep your thoughts clean, positive, and uplifting? (Rev. 7:2–3, 14)
- Are you patient when the Lord is silent? (Rev. 8:1)
- Do you attend your sacrament and other meetings? How well do you prepare for this worship service? (Rev. 9)
- Are you free from media glorifying murder for entertainment purposes? Are you clean of drug abuse? Are you free from pornography? Are you free from stealing? (Rev. 9:21)
- How would you rate your personal scripture study? (Rev. 10:8–9)
- Do you have faith in God's timetable? Do you cling to hope when all seems lost or doomed? (Rev. 11:9–12)
- How often do you share your testimony? Do you find ways to testify and "let your voice be heard" through social media and other means? (Rev. 12:7–12)
- Do you ever accuse or judge others? Are you quick to forgive? (Rev. 12:10)
- Have you marked your life with indications of Christianity? Do pictures of temples and the Savior adorn your home? Do your conversations and your appearance show the marks of being a faithful follower of the Savior? (Rev. 13:18)
- How could you arrange your schedule to attend the temple more often than you do? (Rev. 14:6)
- Do you rest from your labors? Are you too busy? (Rev. 14:13)
- Do you watch and listen to good media? (Rev. 15:2–3, see also verse 4)
- If you have been endowed, do you remember to properly wear your temple garments? If you have not yet been endowed, does your current wardrobe contain temple-ready clothing? (Rev. 16:15)
- Are you active in the political process? Do you research the current issues and promote platforms harmonious with the gospel? (Rev. 17)
- Do you feel you have completely surrendered and submitted your will to the Lord's? Do you support any group whose teachings are contradictory to the teachings of the Church? (Rev. 18:1–9)
- Do you live the Word of Wisdom? (Rev. 18:23)
- Are you actively strengthening your relationships? Are you free from pride and immorality? Are you living up to the terms of your marriage contract, or covenants? Do you feel that you are 'dressed and ready'? (Rev. 19:7)
- Do you give credit to God when people compliment you or your family? (Rev. 19:11–13)
- Do you actively seek for conversion through the Holy Ghost? (Rev. 19:11–13)
- Are you making choices in your life that bind the influence of the adversary? (Rev. 20:1–3)
- Have there been any sins in your life that should have been worked out with priesthood leaders but haven't been? (Rev. 20:12–14)
- Are you preparing your family for the Second Coming? (Rev. 22:6–7)
